Class Descriptions

Class: Internet Research, Presented By: Sam Palmer

Description: This class will cover a variety of tools, resources and websites to assist participants in locating Defendant / Suspect addresses, work locations, identifying financial assets for seizure, and conduction background checks.

Class: Mandatory Reporting, Presented By: AZPOST Instructor

Description: This class will cover State and Federal guidelines regarding the mandatory reporting of crimes including Elder and Child abuse.

Class: Elder Abuse / Child Abuse, Presented By: AZPOST Instructor

Description: This class will discuss in detail what elder abuse and child abuse is, how to identify it and how to prevent it. It will also discuss in further detail the responsibilities and liabilities of the Peace Officer when encountering cases of elder and child abuse.

Class: Critical Incident Stress Management, Presented By: AZPOST Instructor

Description: This training course is designed to present the core elements of a comprehensive, systematic approach to crisis intervention. The course prepares participants to provide a wide range of crisis intervention services to include pre and post incident crisis education, spousal/significant

other support, on-scene support, crisis intervention for individuals, mobilization and demobilization after traumatic events and small group defusing. The need for appropriate follow-up, professional referrals and peer limitations is also discussed.

Class: What You Do Matters, By: AZPOST Instructor

Description: This course examines policing within the legal and political framework of Nazi Germany, a journey that eventually turned those who should protect life and liberty into those who intimidated, humiliated, deported, and eventually murdered millions of innocent people? Using historical images and stories from the holocaust, the course utilizes trained facilitators to engage students in a dialogue about the role of law enforcement in today's communities and the importance of core values in ensuring the integrity and vibrancy of democracy.

Class: Generations, By: AZPOST Instructor

Description: Participants will gain an understanding of the different needs, attitudes, and approaches to life between today's four generations: Matures, Baby Boomers, Generation X, and Millennial. Learn why typical approaches no longer work with the four generations and how stereotyping hinders communication and understanding the most common generational sticking points and discuss solutions.
